


ID Card Photo Requirements







Digital Photo:

- The image must be coloured with a white background.
- The image resolution should be 300 DPI.
- The image size must be 32.5mm x 43mm (3:4 aspect ratio)
- The size of the picture must not exceed 2 MB.
- The resolution of the image must be 1244×933 pixels.
- The photo format must be (jpeg. jpg.)

Printed Photo:

- The image must be coloured with a white background.
- The size of the photo frame should be 4*6 cm.
- No creases or tears.
- Must be unmarked on both sides.
- Image should not be shiny.



ID Card Photo Requirements

























The photo must fulfill the following Standards:

- The picture must be recent, not exceeding 6 months before submitting the application.
- The photo must be coloured with a white background.
- The photo must not be altered in any way (using any photo editing programs).
- The applicant's photo must show the whole head and top of the shoulders.
- The face must be centered & takes up 70% 80% of the photograph.
- The space from the top edge of the picture to the head should be at least 3mm and a maximum of 4mm.
- The applicant's photo must not be over or under-exposed.
- The photo must show the applicant facing forward and looking directly at the camera showing both edges of the face.
- Red eyes & flash reflection must be avoided in the photo during photography.
- The face of the applicant's photo must be fully visible and not covered.
- The applicant eyes must be open and clearly visible.
- Maintain a neutral facial expression.



ID Card Photo Requirements



Head Coverings:

When wearing the Veil and Ghutra but the applicants' full face must be visible, and the head covering must not cast any shadows on the face.



Glasses:

- The eyes must be clearly recognizable; reflections from the glasses are not permitted.
- The edge of the glasses or the frames must not cover any part of the eyes and thick frames should be avoided, if possible.
- Tinted glasses or coloured contact lenses that hide the original eye colour will not be accepted.





Children's photography:

- Children must be on their own in the photo.
- Children under 5 do not have to look directly at the camera.
- Children under 1 do not need to have their eyes open. If their head is supported by a hand, the hand must not be visible in the photo.
